

Short. If I had to choose one word to describe this story, that would be it. In television terms, the whole thing would be about four minutes. As the title suggests, the new Doctor chooses some clothes. The traditional re-visitation of previous costumes is used, but with a twist - the Doctor accidentally tries on one of the costumes of a former companion!

There are a couple of images in this story I could have done without, not least of which is the Doctor standing naked in front of a mirror. This raises questions to which I really don't think we need the answers and if we did have them, I believe they would probably detract from our enjoyment of Doctor Who. The other image I didn't like was the suggestion that this Doctor looks like a lead character from another series, as I feel this can create misleading preconceptions of the new Doctor. I also found one or two of the Doctor's comments a little too transatlantic for my tastes - especially the use of "aw" instead of "ah" or "oh".

Still, several of the ideas in the story are very amusing, especially the trunk. **6/10**
